It is the duty of the fair veterinarian to inspect all animals entering the Clark County Fair. It is the fair veterinarian's responsibility to see that the health standards are those required by the State of Ohio Department of Agriculture. The fair veterinarian will be available for professional services at the fair if needed. Persons have the privilege to contact another veterinarian if they so desire. It is recommended that the exhibitor call a small animal veterinarian, in the event that a small animal becomes ill, in most cases a charge will be made to the exhibitor. In the event that an animal becomes ill, the fair veterinarian has the authority to send the animal home if it is in the best interest of all other exhibitors.

The fair veterinarian's headquarters will be located in the Administration Office. The telephone number there is 323-3090.
