Specific Rules:

- ARBA sanctioned show to be held @ the Clark County Fair at the Big Entertainment Tent on Sunday, July 22nd. This is a single show, **OPEN only**.
- Entries in this department, which includes pre-entry exhibitors & all Junior Fair members showing in Open Class, must be postmarked before 4:30 pm, June 29, 2018. Entries must include class number, breed, variety, sex, ear numbers (see rabbit entries form after special contests) & noted if 4-H / FFA. Entries in the department are open to the world.
- Make checks & money orders payable & send to the Clark County Fair, 4401 S Charleston Pike, Springfield OH 45502, to arrive no later than the closing date.
- EXHIBITORS ENTERING THE OPEN CLASS RABBIT SHOW HAVE 2 OPTIONS:**
 - Pre-entry exhibitors entering the rabbit show will be required to pay the following entry fee; which must accompany the entry blank. Pre-entry / cooping is **optional for Clark County residents**. Cooping is available if needed.
Please indicate if rabbits will require a coop in the open class area; or if the rabbit will be housed as a 4-H / FFA project.
\$1.00.....per single rabbit \$1.00.....per meat pen (consisting of 3 rabbits)
\$1.00.....per single fryer \$1.00.....per fur entry
 - Day of the show exhibitors will be required to pay the following entry fee prior to show, plus admission to the Clark County Fair.
\$2.00.....per single rabbit \$2.00.....per meat pen (consisting of 3 rabbits)
\$2.00.....per single fryer \$1.00.....per fur entry
Day of show check in & entry time will be on Sunday, July 22nd from 7:30 am – 8:30 am. Day of show exhibitors must take their rabbits home after the show is completed. No cooping is available for day of show entries.
- Pre-entry exhibitors must have their stock on the grounds & in the assigned space no later than **8:00 pm – Friday, July 20th**.
- Stock must be checked in and out by the superintendent in charge. Check in times 3:00 pm – 8:00 pm (same as 4-H / FFA).
- All cooped rabbits are released Thursday, 7:00 pm – 10:00 pm or between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm Friday, July 27th.
- This show will be governed by the latest rules of ARBA and will be an official sanctioned show.
- All stock must be permanently tattooed in the left ear before arrival at the show. There **will not** be a registrar available at this fair show.
- Each rabbit must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- No rabbit under 3 months will be accepted **without permission.....NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- We reserve the right to refuse any entries that are not healthy.
- No substitutions, but the same breed, sex, class & variety.
- Judging will start at 9:00 am, Sunday July 22nd.
- The Clark County Agricultural Society will not be responsible for loss or damage to stock during the show.
- Absolutely no breeding of rabbits at the show.
- Premiums will be awarded on sanctioned breeds provided 10 or more are shown.
- In those classes in which there is no competition, no more than two premiums will be awarded to the same exhibitor in any one class. The judge shall have the right to refuse to award a premium when, in his opinion, the animal does not merit one.
- Trophies for Best in Show, Best 4-Class & Best 6-Class will be awarded from the Clark County Agricultural Society.
- Any breed not having 20 or more entries may not be sanctioned next year.
- All exhibitors will be required to carry their own rabbits to the show table.** For cooped rabbits, carriers must be used to transport rabbits from barn to the show area. Exhibitors will be called 2 times to the show table. After 2 times, the show will progress and the rabbit will be scratched.
- All exhibitors must bring their own feed & bedding.
- The Rabbit Barn will be open every morning at 7:00 am and close every night at 10:00 pm.
- All exhibitors **are required to feed, water & "clean" their cages daily.** Feed & water containers must be furnished by the exhibitor. No zip ties or strings are to be used to secure water bottles, springs preferred. **Exhibitors are encouraged to use risers in their cages. 20" x 20" dimensions.**
- No CULL BUYER will be available at this fair show.

Premium checks will be available for payment during the fair • dates will be announced during the fair.
ONLY OUT OF COUNTY premium checks will be mailed. Checks under \$5.00 will not be mailed.
