County Engineer

Johnathan Burr took office as County Engineer in 2009. He is responsible for 309 miles of roadway, 240 bridges and 28 county-maintained ditches. He manages a \$7 million budget each year. Since he took office, he has brought in \$52 million in grants for various roadway improvement projects and bridge replacements. John has run projects as large as \$7.5 million. During his tenure he has replaced over 60 bridges. He assists the townships and villages with roadway improvement projects and grant projects. He has been very supportive and helpful with the fair and maintenance of the fairgrounds through the years.
