- 4. Fruit and tomatoes must be processed in either a boiling water bath or steam pressure canner. Low acid vegetables must be processed in a steam pressure canner. No other methods will be accepted. NO PARAFFIN NO OPEN KETTLE!
- 5. All entries must have been prepared since August, 2019. Winning entries will be marked.
- 6. Please bring entries through the back entrance of the building. There will be no parking in front of the Arts & Crafts Building on Friday, July 24, 2020!
- 7. Please Note the categories where two (2) jars are needed. After judging, you <u>must pick up</u> the jars that were opened by the judges after 1:00 p.m. on Saturday July 25, 2020. This will prevent spoilage of food.
- Exhibits <u>must be picked up</u> on Saturday August 1, 2020 in the Arts & Crafts Building between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. <u>ONLY</u>. <u>NO EARLY PICKUP!</u> Exhibits cannot be taken to the Fair Office and the committees are not responsible for unclaimed exhibits.
