- 4. Special premiums will be given to first place winners in the designated categories.
- 5. Due to limited space please refrain from entering large items. The Committee reserves the right to reject any item that they feel to be too large.
- 6. Ceramic items are limited to 24 inches & no potted plants or live flowers of any kind in ceramic items.
- 7. Any item with more than one piece (such as a scene) must be taped down or fastened in place, to keep from getting broken. Cords must be taped.
- 8. All items must be initialed and dated on the bottom. Work must have been done during the present term.
- 9. This year as in years past the judge will be brought in from out of town.
- 10. Please bring entries through the entrance of the building. <u>There will be no parking at the ANNEX Building on Friday July 23!</u>
  - 11. Exhibits must be picked up on Saturday July 31 in the ANNEX Building between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. ONLY. No early pick-ups! Exhibits cannot be taken to the Fair Office and the committees are not responsible for unclaimed exhibits.
