Important Notice: All Exhibitors must purchase either a Membership, Exhibitor/Privilege Ticket and complete the Open Class Entry Blank in fair book or Online at www.clarkcoag.com.
Exhibitors in the Children's Divisions are not required to purchase Exhibitor Tickets but are required to make their own entry. See the Arts & Crafts Building General Rules in this book before proceeding.

Please Note: All items in this department are eligible for points in the Creative Achievement Award except the People's Choice Best Decorated Canning Jar Contest. (See Department 115 for more details.)

Specific Rules

1. Entries are open to Clark County Residents only.
2. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.
3. Not more than one entry will be permitted in any one class.
4. Canned items are to be displayed in standard half pint, pint, or quart canning jars with regulation sealed top.
5. All bands should be removed from each jar before entering *Unless Noted Otherwise*.
6. Any lid showing rust will be immediately disqualified.
7. Any unclean jar will be immediately disqualified.
8. Judges will award winners when deemed applicable. Not every class will have a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place if not deemed necessary.
9. There will be one (1) Best in show Ribbon for the whole department.
10. Entries must show proper USDA headspace recommendations. Entries noticeably showing improper headspace will not be judged.
11. There are to be no names or writing on jars. Entries should be labeled in this manner:
 - Note Card- Division Name, Class #, if *other* please list, & Date Processed
 - Please determine your entry division and class before entering the annex.
 - You will need to provide your own notecard for each entry. Standard 3x5 or 4x6 notecards are appropriate.
 - Upon Entry, you will receive an entry # and on your note card you will place your assigned #.
12. Fruit and tomatoes must be processed in either a boiling water bath or steam pressure canner. Low acid vegetables must be processed in a steam pressure canner. No other methods will be accepted. NO PARAFFIN- NO OPEN KETTLE!
13. All entries must have been prepared since August 2024.
14. Please note the categories where two (2) jars are needed and which jar they should be presented.
15. Entries with improper jars, bands remaining where not needed, or improper quantities will not be judged.
16. After judging, you must pick up the jars that were opened by the judges after 1:00 pm on Saturday, July 19, 2025. This will prevent food spoilage.
17. Exhibits must be picked up on Saturday, July 26, 2025, in the ANNEX Building between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. ONLY. NO EARLY PICKUP! Exhibits cannot be taken to the Fair Office and the committees are not responsible for unclaimed exhibits.

Rules:

1. Open to Clark County Residents only.
2. Entries are to be done entirely by the exhibitor. Only one (1) entry per family per class.
3. Canning Jars are staged on white tables with no background.
4. Write a description on a 4" x 6" index card.
5. Bring entries to the ANNEX Building on Friday, July 18, 2025 between 3:00 p.m. & 8:00 p.m. to the Canned Fruits and Vegetables Department. (Please bring entries through the back entrance of the building. There will be no parking at the Arts & Crafts Building on Friday July 18!)
6. If the entrant is purchasing a Membership, Exhibitor/Privilege or Exhibitor ticket, they may include entry in this contest on their open class entry form as the category listed below. Persons wishing to enter only this contest may use the open class entry form online and must pay a \$5.00 Exhibitor fee. Entry forms are also available at the fair office.
7. Winners will be selected by public ballot during the first five days of the Fair. Ballots will be available in the ANNEX Building. Results of balloting will be posted at noon on Thursday, July 24, 2025.
8. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places
