- 5. Ceramic items are limited to 24 inches & no potted plants or live flowers of any kind in ceramic items.
- 6. Any item with more than one piece (such as a scene) must be taped down or fastened in place to keep from getting broken. Cords must be taped.
- 7. <u>All items must be initialed and dated on the bottom</u>. Work must have been done during the present term.
- 8. This year as in years past the judge will be brought in from out of town.
- 9. Please bring entries through the entrance of the building. There will be no parking at the ANNEX Building on Friday July 18th!
- 10. Exhibits must be picked up on Saturday July 26th in the ANNEX Building between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. ONLY. No early pick- ups! Exhibits cannot be taken to the Fair Office and the committees are not responsible for unclaimed exhibits.
