Fruits and vegetables are to be displayed in clear pint glass jars, (do not put your name on jars) NEW LIDS AND RINGS or containers as described and must be properly labeled as per each category. The judges shall have the right to open any or all canned goods. Soiled or damaged articles will not be considered by the judges.
- 4. Fruit and tomatoes must be processed in either a boiling water bath or steam pressure canner. Low acid vegetables must be processed in a steam pressure canner. No other methods will be accepted. NO PARAFFIN - NO OPEN KETTLE!
- All entries must have been prepared since August 2021. Winning entries will be marked. Please bring entries to the building. There will be no parking in front of the ANNEX Building on Friday, July 22, 2022!
- 7. Please note the categories where two (2) jars are needed. After judging, you must pick up the jars that were opened by the judges after 1:00 p.m. on Saturday July 23, 2022. This will prevent food spoilage.
- Exhibits must be picked up on Saturday, July 30, 2022, in the ANNEX Building between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. ONLY. NO. EARLY PICKUP! Exhibits cannot be taken to the Fair Office and the committees are not responsible for unclaimed exhibits.
